WSSA STANDARD INSTRUCTIONS: All WSSA standard instructions, found in the front of this book, shall apply, except as may be amended herein.

REGISTRATION: Pre-registration by mail is encouraged (including BYC yachts) by June 4th or delivered to the race committee not less than 30 minutes prior to the first warning signal.

COURSE: Start off the "gazebo" at the foot of Trenton Ave. Round Blake Island in *either* direction, return to the start line and finish. The course may be shortened on the return leg at Orchard Point, at a line running between the committee boat and the Orchard Point Light.

DISTANCE: 17 nautical miles.

DESCRIPTION OF MARKS:

Start/finish line
Blake Island
Orchard Point

TIME LIMIT: Seven (7) hours for each division. Yachts finishing after the time limit will be scored as DNF.

SCORING: Time-on-distance.

STARTING: First warning 9:30. Races shall be started by using the signals in Sailing Instruction 7.

TROPHIES: BYC trophies will be awarded for each division as follows: 1st place (3 or more entries), 2nd place (4 or more entries), 3rd place (5 or more entries).
